ORDINANCE 25-231

AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE PROPERTY OF 201 1ST STREET NORTH OWNED BY CITY OF ALABASTER FROM I (INSTITUTION DISTRICT) TO B-3 (COMMUNITY BUSINESS DISTRICT)

THE PUBLIC GOOD REQUIRING IT, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALABASTER, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS City of Alabaster, as Owners of land located 201 1st Street North with property being Parcel 13 7 35 4 402 008.000, petitioned the City to rezone said property to B-3 (Community Business District).

WHEREAS the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on this matter on March 25, 2025, and did recommend to the Council that said property be zoned B-3 (Community Business District) without condition.

to B-3 (Community Business District).
