**A RESOLUTION TO CANVASS ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE
2025 ALABASTER MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the general election for the City of Alabaster was duly and legally held on the 26th day of August as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the municipal governing body of the City of Alabaster met on this 2nd day of September 2025, a quorum thereof being present, at 12 o'clock pm., and has canvassed the returns, and has ascertained and determined the number of votes received by each candidate, and

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body has ascertained and determined the result of said election as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alabaster Alabama, as follows:

1. That **Scott Brakefield** received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Mayor** and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2025.
2. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember Ward No. 1**, and that **Mike Meyers** and **Gerry J. Bivins** received the most and second most votes cast for that office, therefore, a **runoff** election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on **Tuesday, September 23, 2025**, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended.
