RESOLUTION 041425-E

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AGREEMENTS FOR A LED STREETLIGHT
UPGRADE PROJECT WITH ALABAMA POWER FOR THE
KINGWOOD COMMUNITY, GREENFIELD SUBDIVISION, SOUTHFIELD SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alabaster, Alabama, have determined that it is both wise and expedient to authorize the Mayor to sign an agreement with Alabama Power for the installation of these lights and allow Alabama Power to continue to maintain the lights, and

WHEREAS, City Administration has met with Alabama Power regarding the streetlights and recently discovered that were unmetered lights that were inadvertently omitted from the City’s bill, and

The following streetlights have been identified:

- 9 LED streetlights located in the Kingwood Community at the intersection of King Charles Way-King Charles Ln - King James Ct at a cost of \$129.42 monthly
- 13 LED decorative fixtures in Greenfield Subdivision at a cost of \$161.72 monthly
- 10 LED decorative fixtures in Southfield Subdivision at a cost of \$124.40 monthly

WHEREAS, said LED Lighting installation will result in a **\$415.54 monthly cost** to the City and provide increased illumination and safety for these subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, said contract term shall be 36 months and will renew annually following the initial contract term.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alabaster, does hereby authorize Scott Brakefield, Mayor of the City of Alabaster, to sign all documentation necessary to facilitate said contract and Mark Frey, City Clerk, to attest and file required documentation.
