AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STONE & SONS FOR THE MODIFICATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF THOMPSON RD/1ST AVE W/NAVAJO TRAIL

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alabaster, contracted with Sain Associates in January of 2024, to investigate potential improvements for traffic signals located at the intersection of 1st Ave West/Thompson Road and Navajo Trail, and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is both wise and expedient to follow the recommendations of the analysis as provided and contract with Stone & Sons Electrical Contractors, INC. for the following:

- 1. Follow the project plan recommendation from Sain Associates dated 7-8-24.
- 2. Provide basic traffic control. (Assistance from Alabaster Police Officers to direct traffic during changeover will be required.)
- 3. All the work is to be done in normal business hours.
- 4. Included: the signals, new messenger cable, and new multiconductor cable.
- 5. New service pole and service. (No APCO costs included.)
- 6. Installation of the Owner supplied controller/cabinet.
- 7. Installation of the Owner supplied radar equipment.
- 8. This work will be performed under a mutually agreed upon subcontract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alabaster, Alabama, at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and attest the agreement with Stone & Sons Electrical Contractors, INC. for the traffic signal improvements located at the intersection of 1st Ave West/Thompson Road and Navajo Trail in the amount not to exceed \$80,000.
- 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Alabaster, Alabama.
