RESOLUTION 122722

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR DEMOLITION OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS AND VISITORS BLEACHERS AT THE THOMPSON FOOTBALL STADIUM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alabaster have determined that it is both wise and expedient to enter an agreement for demolition of multiple buildings and the visitor stands at the existing Thompson High School Stadium of the City of Alabaster; and

WHEREAS, this project was posted and advertised in accordance with State Law with a bid opening held on December 22, 2022 at 2:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, in total, four responsive bids were received, as shown in the table below:

WHEREAS, Ingle Demolition & Salvage, Inc. submitted a lump-sum bid with no conditions and is being awarded the bid; and

WHEREAS, City Administration and CMH Architects, Inc. have recommended awarding the bid for construction of the Thompson High School Stadium Demolition Project to **Ingle Demolition & Salvage, Inc.** in the amount of **\$196,930.00**.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alabaster, Alabama:

1. The City Council awards the bid to **Ingle Demolition & Salvage, Inc.** and authorizes demolition of multiple buildings and the visitor stands at the existing Thompson High School Stadium in an amount not to exceed **\$196,930.00**.
2. The City Council also directs Scott Brakefield, Mayor, and J. Mark Frey, City Clerk, to execute and attest all documentation necessary to complete this transaction.
