# **Lacey's Grove Traffic Calming - Speed Humps**

Discuss the use of traffic calming within the Lacey's Grove subdivision.

The committee and City Staff members discussed the request for traffic calming within the Lacey's Grove subdivision. It was discussed that we need a letter from the homeowner giving permission to to have the HOA vote. The request is for a March 1st start date. This will require a 57% affirmative vote from the homeowners.

### **AFD Transport Service Update**

Review information related to the new Alabaster Fire Department transport service.

Chief Love reported:

- -New transport service has been very successful
- -Recommends future transport vehicles be purchased directly in order to expedite warranty work
- -AFD can do infusions on shift now
- -Recommends moving to 4% fee instead of current flat rate charging for filing

### **Alabaster Police Department Update**

The committee will have a general discussion about APD.

- -5 people are retiring. HR assisting with filling of these positions.
- -Currently APD has 90 employees
- -Fountain has a leak and this is causing issues with outside lighting

### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Chief Curtis Rigney stated that he would like to discuss a criminal investigation. With that, a Motion was made by Pate, Seconded by Rakestraw to enter Executive Session based on Alabama Code Section 36 25 7 A5. Voting Yea: Farrell, Rakestraw, Pate Motion carried at 5:28 PM.

(5) To discuss information that would disclose the identity of an undercover law enforcement agent or informer or to discuss the criminal investigation of a person who is not a public official in which allegations or charges of specific criminal misconduct have been made or to discuss whether or not to file a criminal complaint. Provided, however, that prior to such discussions a law enforcement officer with authority to make an arrest or a district or assistant district attorney or the Attorney General or assistant attorney general shall advise the governmental body in writing or by oral declaration entered into the minutes that the discussions would imperil effective law enforcement if disclosed outside of an executive session.
