RESOLUTION 101325-A
AWARDING BIDS FOR ALABASTER POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES
AND EQUIPMENT UPFITTING PURCHASES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to provide adequate and efficient equipment for our Police Department to enable them to serve our citizens, and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of replacing certain necessary vehicles and equipment as approved within the 2026 Fiscal Year Budget, and

WHEREAS, some vehicles were not available for purchase on the State Bid Contract and were therefore bid as required by state law, with a bid opening on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, at 10:00 AM, and

WHEREAS, the following RFB was posted and advertised:

2026 CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLE (PPV) – 2WD – 4 DOOR – OR BETTER OR EQUAL QUALITY

and;

WHEREAS, two bids were received:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. City Council awards the bid for ten **(10) 2026 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV Patrol Vehicles** to **Donahoo Chevrolet, LLC** in the amount of \$53,168.00 each, totaling **\$531,680.00**.
2. The Police Department be allowed to purchase vehicle upfitting to include Computer, In-Car Video Recording Systems, Police Radios and Various Emergency Equipment from the state contract or approved purchasing coop as previously authorized within the FY26 Budget.
3. Mayor Scott Brakefield and City Clerk Mark Frey are authorized and directed to execute any related, necessary documents on behalf of the City for said purchases.
