PROCLAMATION

DESIGNATING THE CITY OF ALABASTER AS A SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL CITY

WHEREAS, July 4, 2026, marks the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the founding of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama, through action of the Alabama Legislature and the Governor, established the Alabama USA Semiquincentennial Commission (AMERICA250AL) to plan, promote, and implement programs, events, and commemorations recognizing this historic milestone; and

WHEREAS, AMERICA250AL seeks to engage all Alabamians and all 67 counties in meaningful reflection, education, and celebration of the people, principles, and progress that have shaped our nation over the past 250 years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alabaster recognizes the importance of honoring our shared history, educating future generations, and celebrating the diverse contributions of all Americans and Alabamians to the ongoing story of our nation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alabaster desires to participate in the Semiquincentennial commemoration by supporting educational initiatives, community events, and civic engagement opportunities in partnership with AMERICA250AL;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Brakefield, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Alabaster, do hereby proclaim the City of Alabaster a SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL CITY, and encourage all residents, schools, civic organizations, businesses, and community partners to participate in activities and programs commemorating the 250th anniversary of the United States of America.
