**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Ron Morearty has requested that truck parking be prohibited on both sides of Main Street from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Church Street from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from Main to Church Streets, and that all overnight parking be prohibited on the north side of Main Street from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street west to the alley next to Thrifty-way.

With the newly available truck parking added east of White Star, it is recommended that trucks be directed to park there instead of congesting the downtown area.

The primary reasons for this request are public safety, snow removal, street sweeping/cleaning, and the need to facilitate various activities and community events that take place downtown.

I agree that this is a good idea, especially now that there is another option locally near White Star.
