SUMMARY OF TASKS

Water Fund:

- 1. <u>AMI Radio Read Project</u>:
 - Contracts are signed and in place.
 - Recommendation of Award submitted for the exterior water meters that the Town Staff will be installing.
 - Jorgensen is working with Core and Main contractor on the Notice to Proceed and starting work.
- 2. <u>Development Reviews</u>:
 - No new development reviews this month
- 3. <u>Water Utility Financial Plan:</u> Midwest Assistance Program (MAP) expects to have the water rate study done this Winter
- 4. <u>Water Utility upgrade</u> costs are budgeted to be \$1.44M. This budget includes; Mega-Well connection, controls, well generators, larger well pump and upper hillside tank overflow valve box

Sewer Fund:

1. <u>Sewer and Water Geographical Information System</u> (G.I.S.) files have not been received from Midwest Assistance Program yet. We are expecting the GIS files this Winter

Pre-Treatment Building Update:

- 1. Building construction;
 - o 40-day public notice of final payment was completed Oct. 7, 2024
 - \circ $\;$ Final financial costs are being worked out with general contractor $\;$
 - General contractor has leaks in the underground tanks that need to be sealed

- 2. <u>Process Piping Systems construction;</u>
 - o Submittals for equipment are being reviewed as they are sent in
 - o Weekly construction status meetings continue
 - Some miscellaneous change orders are being recognized due to missing information on the drawings
 - Cambrian Innovation did not order two pumps that have affected the completion date. Contract completion date needs to be pushed back to November
 - o Plant start-up is scheduled for December
 - Plant turn-over to the Town is expected to be in January

Miscellaneous Items;

- 1. <u>Lot 237 Terrace Lane</u> communication continues between Mr. David Dobler and Jorgensen Survey Department
- 2. <u>Water and Sewer Capacity Study</u> was memorialized in a summary memo and presented to the Town Council
