



TOWN OF ALPINE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2026-019
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND ACCEPTING THE MILL LEVY TAX BASE OF FIVE (5)
MILLS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2027

WHEREAS as provided by Article 15, Section 6 of the Wyoming Constitution, municipal governments are authorized to levy a maximum of eight (8) mills on the real property and improvements located within their town boundaries; and

WHEREAS it is the understanding of the Alpine Town Council that the Alpine Fire District will be receiving three (3) mills of the eight (8) mills available from the County, thereby reducing the total amount available to the Town of Alpine to five (5) mills.

WHEREAS the Town of Alpine has determined that the maximum authorized mill levy of five (5) mills is necessary and required to assist the Town of Alpine in meeting its financial responsibilities and liabilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Alpine shall hereinafter be imposed a tax levy of five (5) mills on each and every dollar of the assessed valuation of the land and real property within the town boundaries of the Town of Alpine for the Fiscal Year 2027, **July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2027.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Eric Green, Mayor of the Town of Alpine, is hereby authorized to sign this resolution and that it is hereby accepted in its entirety and will be effective immediately with the passage of this resolution.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED by the Town Council of the Town of Alpine, Wyoming, this 17th day of March 2026.
