Water and Wastewater Data

Old Business Updates

- The AMI meter replacement project is nearing completion, with only a handful of meters remaining throughout the system. At Targhee Place, 20 meters remain to be installed. Staff anticipate completing these installations by September 1, 2026.
- Twin D completed sewer main jetting in Area 4 last week, with the remaining work finished on Monday. The project was highly successful and resulted in a significant cleaning of the Town's sewer infrastructure.

Current Business Updates

- The Mega Well tie-in project continues to progress smoothly. Staff held the 50% project review meeting with the Wyoming Water Development Commission (WWDC) and Sunrise Engineering on August 6, 2026. The project remains on schedule, and the next major milestone will be the WWDC 90% review meeting, anticipated in the coming weeks.

Future Business Updates

- The Homeland Security grant agreements for generators at the well house and Civic Center have been signed, allowing the projects to move forward. These generators will strengthen the Town's emergency preparedness and help protect essential facilities during power outages.
- Staff are obtaining additional quotes for the Greys River Road pavement project.

Upcoming Construction Activity

- Town of Alpine/Sunrise Engineering—Water Well No. 4 tie-in: Date and time to be determined.

- Installation of the new Civic Center generator: Date and time to be determined.
