# **Summary of Tasks**

## Water Fund:

#### 1. AMI Radio Read Project:

- Weekly construction meetings are being held to communicate with construction group
- Contractor Core & Main is finalizing the last submittal for the concrete vault at the Targhee Village location. This is part of Change Order-2
- Town Public Works has installed all of their exterior water pit meters and antennas. These meters have been tested and are operational.
- Installation of the [3] of the last [4] concrete vaults and meters is scheduled for the next two weeks. These last vaults are; 504 Snake River Dr, RV Park and Jenkins Hardware
- Hydro-Corp, subcontractor of Core & Main, will be in Town from August 18<sup>th</sup> through August 29<sup>th</sup> installing the interior water meters and associated antennas. There are currently about 90-homes that have not responded to their mailers, calls and social media to schedule their meter replacement.
- Operational system is anticipated for the end of September. Core & Main did not achieve their contracted August 1<sup>st</sup> completion date and are now in the liquidate damages timeframe
- The added Targhee Village vault and other larger meters, Change Order-2, will be completed by the end of December but will not affect start-up of the system or be added to the liquidated damages.

#### 2. Development Reviews:

 Dead Horse Lot-1 = the sewer lift station has be reviewed with Public Works Director and sent back to the contractor

### 3. Water Rate Recommendations:

 A workshop with Council and the general public is being scheduled to review needed cost increases

#### 4. Water Permitting:

• DEQ permitting for AWD-4 Well to commence upon final recommendation from Sunrise Engineering water study master plan.

## Sewer Fund:

## 1. <u>Sewer Rate Recommendations:</u>

• A workshop with Council and the general public is being scheduled to review needed cost increases. The rate changes are looking at adjusting the monthly base rates to maintain a steady operational cash flow for the enterprise fund.

## 2. Wastewater Plant Permit

• Public Works received its renewal permit which will expire in June 2030

# 3. <u>Pre-Treatment Plant Update:</u>

- General contractor, Snake River MEP, has pushed forward all phases of the project
- Current schedule is;

Sept. 3<sup>nd</sup> = plant commissioning

Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> = plant start-up

Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> = gas monitor installation

Sept. 29<sup>th</sup> = screen commissioning

Oct. 7<sup>th</sup> = de-water press start-up
