Subject: Alpine Meadows Sewer Issue

Dear Mayor Green and the Alpine Town Council,

Thank you for your work on the Alpine Meadows sewer issues. Our house at 399 Columbine St. is the home that was identified in November as lacking a connection between the lateral and main sewer line.

After the Town of Alpine connected the lateral and main lines, we requested reimbursement for our plumbing bill to diagnose the issue. We were told that the town could not reimburse us, and our only recourse was to file an insurance claim through the Wyoming Local Government Liability Pool (LGLP) via the Town of Alpine. We submitted the claim in the fall and it was later denied. A copy of the claim and the letter from LGLP denying the claim are attached.

Our diagnostic bill is over \$2,100. All of the property owners in our neighborhood had their sewer connections evaluated at no expense to themselves. Several years ago, two homes in the neighborhood were identified with no sewer connections and the town of Alpine paid their diagnostic bills. We are the only property in the neighborhood being asked to cover this expense.

We are requesting reimbursement for the diagnostic bill attached. We appreciate your time and consideration in this matter.
