A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ALPINE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE AMERICA 250 GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF STATE PARKS AND CULTURAL RESOURCES

WHEREAS, the United States will commemorate the 250th anniversary of its founding in 2026, and the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources is offering grants to support community-based projects that celebrate Wyoming's contributions to national history; and

WHEREAS, the America 250 grant program provides funding for projects including public art, exhibits, historical markers, and community storytelling that align with the Semiquincentennial themes and promote lasting public engagement and education; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Alpine desires to participate in this grant opportunity and pursue eligible projects that reflect Alpine's history, culture, and identity in a meaningful and lasting way; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Alpine recognizes the value of community partnerships, historical preservation, and public education, and wishes to move forward with the preparation and submission of a grant application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ALPINE, WYOMING:

- 1. The Town of Alpine hereby authorizes submission of a grant application to the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources for the America 250 Grant Program.
- 2. The Mayor and Town Clerk are authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to complete the application process.
- 3. The Town of Alpine commits to overseeing the implementation of the project in accordance with all applicable grant requirements, if awarded.
