

RESOLUTION NO. 20260714-009

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS REQUESTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE BRAZOSPORT WATER AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

WHEREAS, the Brazosport Water Authority (BWA) was created by the Texas Legislature in 1985; and

WHEREAS, the BWA is composed of seven cities, including the City of Angleton; and

WHEREAS, according to the BWA bylaws, each city appoints a director to the BWA Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the bylaws state that directors cannot be city employees or elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the City of Angleton has found it difficult to fill the director position with a knowledgeable person that is not an employee of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Angleton, Texas requests that ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP AND DIRECTORS in the BWA bylaws be amended to state:

Incompatibility Provision: Directors must be impartial and free of conflicts. In order to avoid the potential for conflicting interests or incompatible governmental posts, Directors shall not be ~~employees or~~ officers, including but not limited to any elected or appointed positions, for any member city or other governmental entity as may be required and limited by law.
