ORDINANCE 20230425-010

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF §545.356, TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE, UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, OF PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, §545.356, Vermon's Texas Civil Statutes, provides that whenever the governing body of the city shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place upon any part of a street of highway within the city, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall by effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street of highway;

NOW, THEREOF BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The facts recited in the preamble in this Ordinance are hereby found by the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas to be true and correct and are incorporated by reference herein and expressly made a part thereof, as if copied herein verbatim.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation heretofore made as authorized by the provision of §545.356, Texas Transportation Code, the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the name streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

Along State Highway (SH 35) from West Angleton City Limits to the intersection of South Thomas Write Road., a distance approximately 1.175 miles, the speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour (MPH).

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).

<u>SECTION</u> 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on the first day after the date of passage.

SECTION 5. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
