

ORDINANCE NO. 20251028-003

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS,
APPOINTING JEFFREY R. GILBERT THE MUNICIPAL
COURT JUDGE FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF
RECORD OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the Judge of the municipal court shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Angleton and shall be a licensed attorney; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code Section 30.00006 mandates the municipal judge must be a resident of this state, be a citizen of the United States, be a licensed attorney in good standing and have two or more years of experience in the practice of law in this state; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey R. Gilbert is a licensed attorney with over 20 years of experience who has successfully served as the Municipal Court Judge for the Municipal Court of Record of the City of Angleton; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey R. Gilbert is eligible to practice law in the State of Texas and meets all the City Charter and Texas Government Code requirements to serve as the Municipal Court Judge for the Municipal Court of Record of the City of Angleton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Jeffrey R. Gilbert is appointed the Judge of the Municipal Court of Record of the City of Angleton.

SECTION 2. That his two (2) year term of office shall begin on October 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective and in full force immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
