WHEREAS, National Police Week 2026 is to recognize and honor the service and sacrifice of those law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities and safeguarding our democracy; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 800,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicate members of the Angleton Police Department; and

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1786, there are currently more than 24,000 law enforcement officers that have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, National Police Week is observed May 15th – 21st and Peace Officers Memorial day is observed May 15th in honor of all fallen officers and their families and U.S. flags should be flown at half-staff; and

WHEREAS, the City of Angleton publicly salutes the service of law enforcement officers in our community and across the nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Wright, Mayor of the City of Angleton, Texas, along with the City of Angleton City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15-21, 2026 as:

“National Police Week”
