EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

ADAPT Programs, Prevention Department has proposed a Community Partnership Agreement with the City of Angleton Parks & Recreation Department to provide free, youth-focused prevention programming at the Angleton Recreation Center and in coordination with Recreation Division programs. Services may include presentations, activity-based programming, outreach events, and support for summer programming and other community initiatives.

The agreement is structured as a partnership rather than a procurement contract, with ADAPT providing trained staff and program materials at no cost to the City. In turn, the City will provide space, coordination, and general support to facilitate program delivery.

The agreement outlines the roles and responsibilities of both parties, including documentation and reporting requirements to meet grant compliance, as well as standard provisions related to confidentiality, scheduling, and non-discrimination. The agreement term is one year, with flexibility to adjust services as needed.

This item is presented to formally notify City Council of the partnership and to authorize the Acting City Manager to execute the agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the Community Partnership Agreement with ADAPT Programs, Prevention Department, and authorization for staff to execute the agreement.
