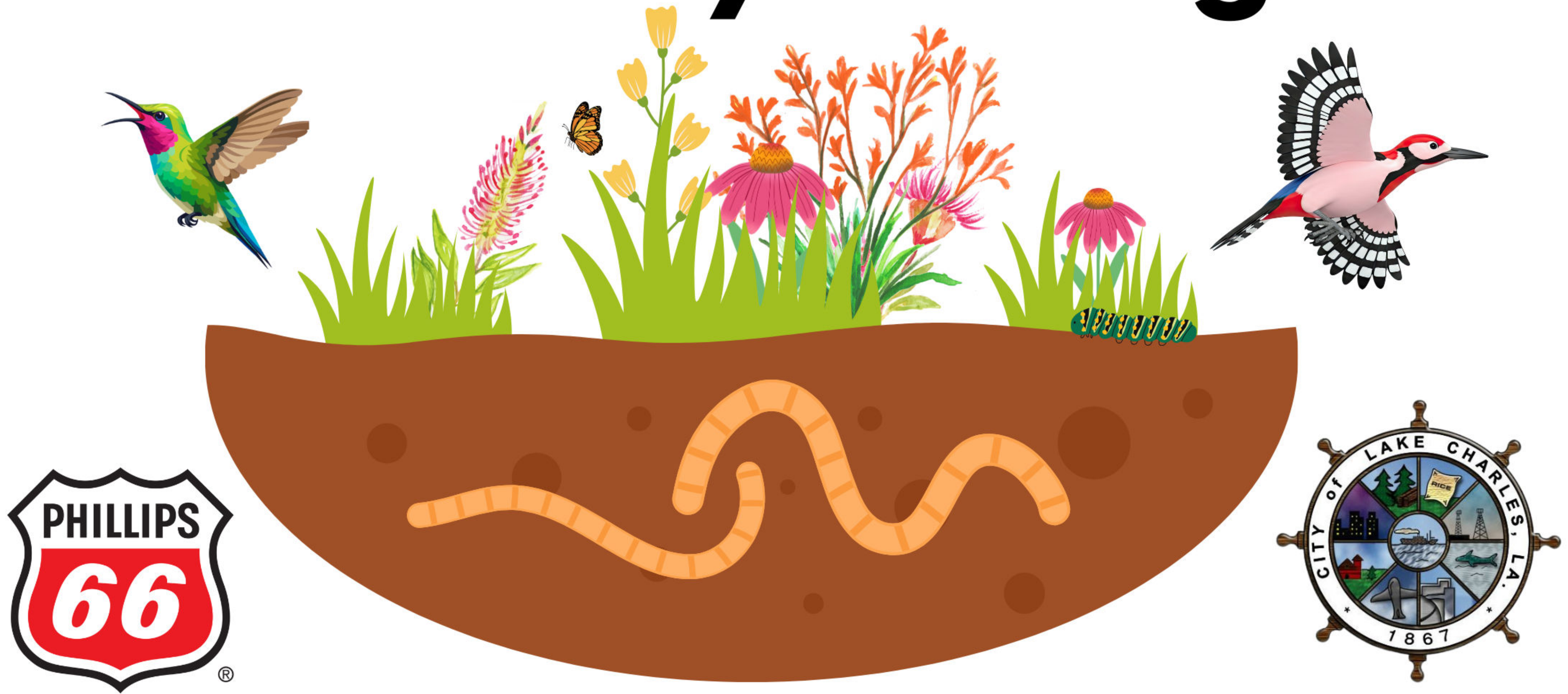

THIS BIOSWALE CAPTURES AND SLOWS RAINWATER RUNOFF. NATIVE WETLAND PLANTS HELP FILTER POLLUTANTS, REDUCE FLOODING, AND ALLOW WATER TO SOAK INTO THE GROUND WHILE STABILIZING SOIL AND PROVIDING HABITAT FOR WILDLIFE.
