EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On January 9, 2024, the Angleton Better Living Corporation (ABLC) approved the replacement of natatorium components for the Angleton Recreation Center for \$200,828.61 with Vortex Aquatic Structures International. Staff requested customized panels on the Playnuk aquatic component, resulting in an additional charge of under \$5000.00.

On June 17, 2024, ABLC authorized an expenditure of \$98,320.00 from ABLC Contingency (40-506-520) for Angleton Recreation Center natatorium component materials to allow the \$500,000 allocated for Angleton Recreation Center improvement funds from the 2024 ABLC Bond to go towards a 50% matching Local Parks Non-Urban Indoor Recreation grant offered by the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department (TPWD).

The Parks & Recreation Department (PARD) staff worked with Vortex Aquatic Structures International and Randle Law Office (RLO) to develop a service agreement for City Council approval. Enclosed are the quote, service agreement, and renderings of the aquatic components.
