Staff will provide the Keep Angleton Beautiful Commission with an update on current and upcoming programs and projects and seek Commission input regarding future beautification initiatives.

Phillips 66 Pollinator Garden – Abigail Arias Park: A new pollinator garden project at Abigail Arias Park being supported through funding from Phillips 66 and developed in coordination with project partners. Planting is anticipated for this fall and is proposed to coincide with the City's Fall Sweep activities. Staff is proposing that participation in the pollinator garden planting serve as KAB's primary fall planting initiative in place of the annual tree planting event this year. The project will provide an opportunity for volunteers to participate directly in establishing native and pollinator-friendly landscaping within the City's newest community park.

2026 Fall Sweep: Scheduled for Saturday, November 7, 2026, from 8:00 to 11:00 at the Angleton Recreation Center Parking lot. Services include heavy trash, data shredding, electronic recycling, tire recycling, paint recycling, flags and eye glass recycling.

Silver Hearts of Angleton / GCAA: Staff is requesting information and historical knowledge from Commission members regarding the Silver Hearts of Angleton entries previously located throughout the community. This information will assist staff in evaluating the existing program and exploring whether restoration, replacement, expansion, or a related beautification initiative could be considered for funding through the City's Governor's Community Achievement Award allocation.

FY 2026-2027 Program Ideas: An opportunity to discuss and identify potential beautification, litter prevention, community engagement, environmental education, or other Keep Angleton Beautiful programs and projects for consideration during FY 2026-2027.
