

RESOLUTION NO. 20260127-003

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GENERAL VICTIM ASSISTANCE GRANT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, TO FUND A CRIME VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; FINDING THAT THE MEETING COMPLIED WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Angleton, for the Crime Victim Assistance Program to be operated for the year 2027; and

WHEREAS, service under such program may include responding to the emotional and physical needs of crime victims, assisting victims in stabilizing their lives after a victimization, assisting victims with safety and security; and

WHEREAS, federal funding is authorized for such projects by the 1984 Victims of Crime Act, as amended and codified in Sec. 20103 of Title 34 of the United States Code and Sec. 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said program as required by the General Victim Assistance Grant Program, FY 2027 application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governors in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas designates the Police Chief, of the Angleton Police Department, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas designates the Director of Finance, of the City of Angleton, as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the findings set out in the preamble to this resolution are in all things approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas, approves submission of the grant application for the Crime Victim Assistance Program to the Office of the Governor.

SECTION 3. City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas designates the Police Chief of the Angleton Police Department, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 4. City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas designates the Director of Finance of the City of Angleton, as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 5. Any prior resolution of the City Council in conflict with the provisions contained in this resolution are hereby repealed and revoked.

SECTION 6. Should any part of this resolution be held to be invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby severable.

SECTION 7. That the meeting at which this resolution was approved was in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.

SECTION 8. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
