2. Discussion of programs and services updated for Keep Angleton Beautiful.

These updates included the upcoming Citywide Spring Cleanup, the upcoming Arbor Day Tree and Butterfly Seedball Giveaway event, the Green Ribbon Project and Loop 274 median landscaping, the Green Garden Series program, the status of KAB's GCAA application, the status of the KTB annual report, volunteer partnerships, and KAB commission member spotlights.

3. Discussion and possible action on Keep Angleton Beautiful Strategic Plan progress updates for 2022.

Upon a motion by member Demopulos-Coats and seconded by Vice Chair Scarborough, the commission approved continuing with the Strategic plan as written and proposed. The motion passed on a 6-0 vote.

4. Discussion and possible action to recommend KAB approval of the top three TxDOT traffic controller cabinet art wrap submissions.

Upon a motion by Member Demopulos-Coats and seconded by Member Brewer, the Commission approved moving forward with approving the top three TxDOT traffic controller cabinet art submission while giving staff the discretion of determining the placement location of each additional art wrap. The motion passed on a 6-0 vote.
