## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

In collaboration with TXU Energy, 23 of 46 solar lights have been installed along the Freedom Park Walking trail. This is a two-year project, and the City was eligible for TXU's Greenback - Energy Efficiency Rebate which awards the City \$13,000 per year for two years. TXU is here to present a check for the 2021 \$13,000 contribution.

The public roadways impacted by the solar lighting project include Dallas Street which received 9 lights, and in progress are Richmond-10 lights, and South Side Drive-15 lights. Future streets to receive lights are Piney Way, Houston, and Bastrop.
