

ORDINANCE NO. 20220913-011

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY OF ANGLETON HOME RULE CHARTER TO CORRECT AND RENUMBER THE CHARTER PROVISIONS FOLLOWING THE ADOPTION BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CHARTER AMENDMENTS APPROVED IN THE MAY 7, 2022 ELECTION AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2022, the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas, ordered a Special Election be held on May 7, 2022, for the purpose of considering possible amendments to the City Charter; and

WHEREAS the City Council determined that the Special Election was duly and legally held on May 7, 2022, in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas and the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and;

WHEREAS the City Council canvassed and accepted the results of the Special Election by adoption of Ordinance Number 20220517-002 on May 17, 2022, and approved and adopted the City Charter Amendment on May 17, 2022, and the Mayor certified the Charter Amendment on May 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS the City Charter Amendment Section 10.13 Amending the Charter provides that City Council may without approval of the voters make non-substantive revisions to the Charter, such as renumbering, adopt an Ordinance with the changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

SECTION 2. The Council finds that the City of Angleton City Charter Section 10.13 provides the City Council by ordinance may make non-substantive changes such as renumbering provisions of the City Charter Amendment; and

SECTION 3. The sections renumbered include the following existing section numbers: 7.04, 8.20, 8.28, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 10.04, 10.05, 10.06, 10.07, 10, 08, 10.12,10.13, 10.14, 10.15, 10.17, sequentially renumbered in the City of Angleton City Charter Amendment attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit “A”; and

SECTION 4. The meeting at which this ordinance was approved was a regular meeting of the City Council, and in all things, was conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
