2. Update from Code Enforcement Division of Development Services, January 01 – March 31, 2022 (Q1)

Kyle Reynolds, Chief Building Inspector for the Development Services department, provided the KAB Commission with updates on the Activities of the Code Enforcement division. These updates included how the city is addressing and remedying substandard structures within the City of Angleton.

3. Discussion on Keep Angleton Beautiful programs and services updates.

Kyle Livesay, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation, provided programs and services updates for the KAB Commission. Updates included the KTB Annual Report, the GCAA

application results, the Arbor Day Tree and Butterfly Seed Ball Giveaway event, the results of the Annual Spring Cleanup, the Results of the Cigarette Butt and Tobacco Product Cleanup Event, and the Green Garden Series programming.

4. Discussion and possible action on the addition of a third citywide cleanup event supported by grant funding provided through the H-GAC Solid Waste Grant.

Upon a motion by Member Demopoulos-Coats and seconded by Member Brewer, the Commission approved staff to move forward in planning a community-wide cleanup event that engages Angleton neighborhoods and community groups in various areas around Angleton to take place in September 2022. The motion passed on a 5-0 vote.
