EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On December 20, staff advertised a Request for Proposal (RFP) for traffic signal controller cabinet wrap art for two new locations within Angleton including: Loop 274 and Locust, Business 288 and Cedar.

This is an opportunity to continue supporting the aesthetic improvement of the state highway system within Angleton city limits and, also, fulfills goal four, revitalize downtown, objective three, attract arts, entertainment, and specialty retail downtown, of the Strategic Plan adopted by City Council on June 26, 2018. KAB provided staff direction regarding a theme which included Texas Wildflowers, historical Texas heroes, coastal birds, and Texas butterflies, for the RFP. The RFP was advertised on December 20, 2022, and closed on January 31, 2023.

Staff received several submissions from three artists which were evaluated and ranked by KAB members. Based on their ranking the recommended submissions for wrap installation are Show Me a Sign by Joy Chandler and Texas Wildflowers by Heather Pizzitola.
