DECLARATION OF A QUORUM AND CALL TO ORDER

Council and Staff discussed current and future facilities.

Martha Eighme, Director of Communications and Marketing, discussed the security issues with visitor's access to the City Hall building and stated that staff has outgrown the location.

Chris Whittaker, City Manager, gave an update on 901. Velasco.

Police Chief Valdez discussed that staff has outgrown the police department building and the back side needs updates. Chief also stated the police department could use more port or storage area. Chief stated he would like Information Technology (IT) to be housed at the police department and will also need to add a receptionist. He stated the animal control facility is also at capacity. Council discussed expanding the animal control facility on the property.

Megan Mainer, Parks and Recreation Director, stated that staff has outgrown the recreation building but does not recommend expansion at this time. There are grants that can be pursued.
