### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

There are four original, antique-style electric streetlights on Colony Drive that have been inoperable for several years. To provide adequate lighting on this street, the old lights must be removed and replaced with up to six new, LED streetlights.

This project will require a contractor to disconnect and pull out the old damaged underground electric cables to each streetlight location. Some of these cables are not visible, therefore their exact route and destinations will have to be determined. The underground junction boxes must be replaced and lowered to allow for mowing. New wire will have to be pulled to each light location. The original breaker panel will have to be disconnected and removed. A new breaker panel and timer control will be installed.

The City will install the streetlights and then the contractor will hook up each light.

The estimate is based on reusing the existing underground conduit, and allowances have been made for unforeseen issues.

### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of removing old streetlights, performing all necessary electrical work, and installing new electrical streetlights on Colony Drive.
