**RESOLUTION AFFIRMING RESOLUTION 25-64 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PROCEED
WITH AN AGREEMENT WITH WILLDAN FINANCIAL SERVICES TO PREPARE A TRAFFIC
IMPACT MITIGATION FEE STUDY**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Angels adopted Resolution No. 16-25 on June 21, 2016, approving the City's existing Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee (TIMF) study; and

WHEREAS, Traffic Impact Mitigation Fees must comply with the California Mitigation Fee Act (Government Code section 66000 et seq.) and applicable constitutional requirements, including the requirement for a legally defensible nexus study; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 24-98 authorizing the release of a Request for Proposals to update the City's 2016 Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee study; and

WHEREAS, following a competitive procurement process, on August 19, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 25-64 awarding a contract to Willdan Financial Services in the amount of \$22,500 to prepare an updated Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee study; and

WHEREAS, the City has since been informed that the Calaveras Council of Governments intends to conduct a countywide Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee study and has offered to include the City of Angels at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the relative timing, governance, and fiscal impacts of proceeding directly with Willdan Financial Services versus participating in the countywide study; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that affirming Resolution No. 25-64 will allow the City to maintain direct oversight of the study and complete the update on an accelerated timeline, with funding available within the Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Fund

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Angles that:

1. Resolution No. 25-64 is hereby **affirmed**.
2. The City Council authorizes the City Administrator to proceed with the agreement with Willdan Financial Services to prepare an updated Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee study.
3. The cost of the study, in the amount of \$22,500, shall be paid from the Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Fund, as previously appropriated.
4. City staff is directed to return to the City Council with the completed study and any necessary actions for consideration and adoption of updated Traffic Impact Mitigation Fees.
