RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE CHIEF OF POLICE JOB DESCRIPTION

WHEREAS, the City of Angels Chief of Police Scott Ellis retired on December 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City of Angels will launch a recruitment to fill the position of Chief of Police on January 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Angels Job Description for the Chief of Police was last updated in August 2020; and

WHEREAS, the current job description for the City of Angels Chief of Police includes a section for Education and Experience; and

WHEREAS, the experience section includes, “Eight (8) years of increasingly responsible sworn law enforcement management experience; at least three (3) years of law enforcement supervisory experience is desirable; and

WHEREAS, Staff believes the reference to “management” was inadvertent and that the intended qualification was eight years of law enforcement experience, including a minimum of three years in a supervisory role.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Angels does hereby modify the Experience section of the Chief of Police Job Description to read, “Eight (8) years of increasingly responsible sworn law enforcement experience; including a minimum of three (3) years in a sworn law enforcement supervisory or management role.”
