**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY, LIMITED-TERM, PART-TIME APPOINTMENT
OF CHRISTOPHER ZANARDI AS A DISTRIBUTION AND COLLECTIONS OFFICER II (PERS
RETIRED ANNUITANT)**

WHEREAS, the City requires the extra-help of temporary, skilled staffing support to maintain essential water distribution and collections operations; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Zanardi is a CalPERS retiree with specialized skills, experience, qualifications, and certifications necessary to perform the full duties of the Distribution and Collections Officer II classification; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code sections 21224, and 7522.56 authorize the temporary employment of retired annuitants to perform extra-help work of limited duration; and

WHEREAS, the proposed appointment is temporary, limited-term, and part-time, does not exceed 960 hours in a fiscal year, and does not include any benefits or compensation beyond the approved hourly rate; and

WHEREAS, the hourly rate of \$29.61 represents Step 5 of the City's publicly adopted salary schedule for the Distribution and Collections Officer II classification.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Angels does hereby authorize the following:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the temporary, limited-term, part-time appointment of Christopher Zanardi as a Distribution and Collections Officer II in a CalPERS retired annuitant capacity, because it finds he has special training, certification, skills and abilities to perform the work to assist with help distribution and collection staff eliminate backlog.
2. The employment shall terminate upon completion of the limited duration work or at any time at the discretion of the City.
3. Christopher Zanardi has been retired from a CalPERS employer for over one-hundred and eighty (180) days.
4. The compensation paid to retirees cannot be less than the minimum nor exceed the maximum monthly base salary paid to other employees performing comparable duties, divided by 173.333 to equal the hourly rate. Compensation for this appointment shall be at Step 5 of the Distribution and Collections Officer II classification, at an hourly rate of \$29.61, which is above the minimum and does not exceed the maximum for the classification assigned to employees performing similar duties.
5. Christopher Zanardi has not and will not receive any other benefit, incentive, compensation in lieu of benefit or other form of compensation in addition to this hourly pay rate.
6. Christopher Zanardi shall certify that he has not received unemployment benefits within twelve (12) months prior to the appointment as an extra-help retired annuitant.
7. The appointment shall comply with all applicable CalPERS retired annuitant requirements, including the 960-hour annual limit and the prohibition on benefits or additional compensation.
8. The Interim City Administrator is authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to implement this resolution.
