¹Turnaround time may vary with the complexity and magnitude of the project. If a review is anticipated to take longer than the maximum turnaround time, CSG will notify the City's representative and negotiate additional time required to ensure an appropriate level of review.

Note: Turnaround times for housing projects subject to State streamlining will comply with State law. This includes, but is not limited to, ADU's, SB 9 units, SB 35, by-right and ministerial housing projects.

Expedited Plan Check Services

At the City's request, we can perform plan check services on an accelerated schedule based on the fees indicated in our fee schedule.

Office Hours and Meeting Availability

CSG plan checkers are available for inquiries anytime during normal business hours via phone or email, Monday through Friday. Our plan checkers can typically respond to the City for all questions or requests generated during any plan review on the same day, but no later than the following day a request is received. This includes a POST certified FTO, trained both as a certified trainer and as a program administrator. CSG offers agencies this same process to facilitate uniformity, structure, and alignment. Additionally, this advanced level of oversight and training will reduce jurisdictional liability and increase performance.

HOUSING INSPECTIONS

Upon request, CSG will conduct inspections in response to complaints about substandard housing consistent with Health and Safety Code Section 17900. Services could include contacting property owners and tenants, conducting inspections, documenting violations, and monitoring repairs.

DANGEROUS BUILDINGS AND PUBLIC NUISANCES

CSG will assist the City and support the Building department in administering the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings and Nuisance Chapter of the Municipal Code, including the following services:

- Conduct preliminary investigations of conditions of property and make initial contact with tenants and property owners as appropriate;

- Conduct inspections and prepare documentation of violations;

- Conduct follow-up inspections to monitor compliance with "Compliance Orders" and "Notice and Orders;"



- Provide support to legal counsel including preparation of declarations and documentation suitable for submission to Court;

- Prepare documentation for recovery of costs through administrative penalties and recordation of liens.
- Appearing as expert witnesses

HEARING OFFICER SERVICES

If requested, CSG will assist the City with an on-call or designated Administrative Hearing Officer providing the following services:

- Conducting Administrative Hearings: CSG's Hearing Officer will preside over administrative hearings and ensure proper conduct during proceedings. CSG's Hearing Officer will hear all parties and review relevant evidence to determine an unbiased decision and/or recommendation based on the facts presented.
- Management of Procedural Issues: This includes ruling on motions, written appeals, and other related evidence. CSG's Hearing Officer also has the authority to administer oaths, receive testimony, and is committed to upholding due process while facilitating an impartial environment where all parties can fairly present their case.
- Records Management: CSG's Hearing Officer will maintain detailed records of all proceedings, compiling all pertinent documents and evidence. Additionally, a transcript of the proceedings can be provided upon request.
- **Issuing Decisions:** After careful review of the evidence, information, and arguments presented during hearings, CSG's Hearing Officer will issue a written decision detailing the findings and a subsequent order and/or remedy to be executed.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All plan review based on percentage of the agency's plan check fees includes the initial plan review and two subsequent reviews. Additional reviews, deferred submittals, revisions, and RFIs will be charged at the appropriate hourly rate.
- Minimum percentagé plan review fee per project excludes Solar, ESS, or EVCS reviews.
- RFIs for large developments will be performed at an hourly rate, and turnaround times will be agreed upon in advance with the agency.
- Depending on project size and scope, CSG's percentage-based expedited plan review rate may be adjusted if mutually agreed upon between the agency and CSG.
- Should the scope of work change or circumstances develop which necessitate special handling, CSG will notify the agency prior to proceeding.
- Overtime/services provided outside of normal business hours will be billed at 1.5x the applicable hourly rate.
- Services provided on weekends/holidays will be billed a 2x the applicable hourly rate.
- Hourly rates for publicly funded projects will be based on current prevailing wage rates.
- On July 1 or the anniversary of the contract start date, CSG will initiate an hourly rate increase based on change in CPI for the applicable region.
- CSG will mail/email an invoice every month for services rendered during the previous month. Unless otherwise agreed, payment terms are 30 days from receipt of invoice.
- If plans are not submitted electronically, CSG will coordinate the pickup and return of all plans to CSG via CSG staff or a licensed courier service.
- For hourly projects only, performance of plan review services utilizing the agency's adopted plan review software (e.g., ProjectDox or Bluebeam Studios) to, for example, markup plans with corrections and redlines and/or coordinate with other internal agencies, may involve additional time being added to the plan review time at the associated plan review rate.
 - *Building Department Special Projects may include developing and establishing the following: building department workflows and relationships with other internal agency departments, building permit code requirements, inspector and permit technician responsibilities, criteria for over-the-counter plan review and out-to-plan check projects, transmittals and routing processes, Building Department handouts for different project types; and may include other duties as assigned by the agency.
 - *Administration/Plan Processing fees are incurred for specific additional services requested by the agency beyond the normally provided CSG administrative services which typically include coordinating the pick-up and return of plans; performing scanning, collating, and tracking; and providing plan review status updates to the agency. Cost for additional services will be negotiated based on the type of request with a minimum fee based on 0.5 hours of service per project.
