**RESOLUTION DECLARING JANUARY 9, 2025, AS A CITY HOLIDAY, FOLLOWING THE  
PRESIDENT'S DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING FOR THE PASSING  
OF PRESIDENT JAMES EARL CARTER, JR.**

**WHEREAS**, on December 30, 2024, President Biden issued an Executive Order closing all executive departments and agencies of the federal government and declaring January 9, 2025, as a National Day of Mourning for the passing of President James Earl Carter, Jr.; and

**WHEREAS**, section 15 of the Angels Exempt Memorandum of Understanding and section 10 of the Angels Miscellaneous Memorandum of Understanding state in part, "... Any additional holidays recognized by the Federal Government shall be an additional holiday and not substituted for any existing holiday."; and

**WHEREAS**, while the City of Angels is not a Federal agency and the President did not declare January 9, 2025, a "Holiday", the County of Calaveras, and the County of Tuolumne have or will declare January 9, 2025, as a holiday within their jurisdiction and will close their offices for the day; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Order issued by President Biden ordered that all executive departments and agencies of the Federal Government shall be closed on January 9, 2025, as a mark of respect for James Earl Carter, Jr., the thirty-ninth President of the United States; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Angels City Council does Approve a Resolution Declaring January 9, 2025, as a City Holiday, following the President's declaration of a National Day of Mourning for the passing of President James Earl Carter, Jr.
