A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ANGELS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE ALLOCATION OF UP TO \$250,000 IN TRAFFIC IMPACT MITIGATION FEES TOWARDS ACQUIRING FOUNDRY LANE ACCESS OFF SR 4 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN, AUTHORIZE, AND EXECUTE ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE DECERTIFICATION

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2025; the City Council adopted the list of proposed road improvements for the current Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) to guide new roadway capital improvements and provide the basis for updating Traffic Impact Mitigation Fees and the top-listed project on the list is Foundry Lane; and

WHEREAS, since 1989, the City has been pursuing access off SR 4 for Foundry Lane for the extensive circulation, safety, and economic development potential for the City associated with Foundry Lane; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans completed an appraisal—the next-to-the-last-step before decertification and the City desires to assist in securing access off SR 4 for Foundry Lane and finalize the decertification;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Angels hereby approves the allocation of up to \$250,000 IN TRAFFIC IMPACT MITIGATION FEES towards acquiring Foundry Lane access off SR 4 and authorizes the city administrator to sign, authorize, and execute all relevant documents and agreements in support of the decertification.
