

ORDINANCE S-324

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE CITY OF ANTHONY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the following described land, commonly identified as the "Solar Field", is located in Harper County, Kansas; and is owned by the City of Anthony, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Anthony finds it advisable to annex such land, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-520c.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANTHONY, KANSAS:

Section 1. Annexation. That the following described land, meeting the conditions for annexation prescribed in K.S.A. 12-520c, is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of Anthony, to wit:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 31 as surveyed by Michael Alldritt RLS 1155, on the 12th day of January 2026 described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 31, Township 33 South, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M., in Harper County, Kansas; Thence Westerly along the North line of said Section 31 and on an assumed bearing of South 88°40'52" West a distance of 809.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; Thence Southerly on a bearing of South 00°27'17" East a distance of 809.00 feet; Thence Westerly on a bearing of South 88°40'52" West a distance of 809.00 feet; Thence Northerly on a bearing of North 00°27'17" West a distance of 809.00 feet to a point on the North line of said Section 31; Thence Easterly along said North line and on a bearing of North 88°40'52" East a distance of 809.00 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said tract contains 15.02 acres of land more or less which includes road right of way on the North.

Section 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 12-520c, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this resolution to the Harper County, Kansas, Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
