Item Details

On February 24, 2026, the Apex Town Council voted to establish an Ad-Hoc Finance Committee to provide input and oversight over the Town's Annual Operating Budget for the upcoming fiscal year (2026-27) with an end date of June 30, 2026, or until the Council Committee structure was resolved. Subsequently, the Town Council voted to appoint Mayor Pro-Tempore Mahaffey and Councilmember Gray to the Ad-Hoc Finance Committee. Those individuals previously served as the Finance Committee before the Council Committee structure was changed, effective January 1, 2026.

On April 21, 2026, the Town Council voted to resolve the Council Committee membership appointments effective immediately, however, the Ad-Hoc Finance Committee already had special meetings scheduled. Given the previous motion on February 24, 2026, stated that the Ad-Hoc Finance Committee would exist

until June 30 **or** until the Council Committee structure was resolved, an official action is requested to confirm this committee's continued participation through June 30, 2026.
