



**Description of the proposed update(s):**

To qualify for federal grants in the event of a disaster, federal law requires that state and local governments to develop hazard mitigation plans and update them every 5 years. The last update to the Wake County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was in 2019. This plan expires in January 2025. Since January 2024, Town staff has been working with a consultant and other Wake County municipalities on a new revised Hazard Mitigation Plan. This plan includes updated analysis, maps, action items, and capability plan.
