

STATEMENT OF TOWN COUNCIL AND ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING DISTRICT MAP OF THE TOWN OF APEX TO CHANGE THE ZONING OF APPROXIMATELY 10.39 ACRES LOCATED AT 0 CANDUN DRIVE, 0 LAURA DUNCAN ROAD, AND 0 NORTH SALEM STREET FROM PLANNED COMMERCIAL (PC) & NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS (B1) TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT-CONDITIONAL ZONING (PUD-CZ)

#21CZ29

WHEREAS, Ana Wadsworth with The Wooten Company, owner/applicant (the “Applicant”), submitted a completed application for a conditional zoning on the 1st day of December 2021 (the “Application”). The proposed conditional zoning is designated #21CZ29;

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning and Community Development for the Town of Apex, Dianne Khin, caused proper notice to be given (by publication and posting) of a public hearing on #21CZ29 before the Planning Board on the 11th day of April 2022;

WHEREAS, the Apex Planning Board held a public hearing on the 11th day of April 2022, gathered facts, received public comments and formulated a recommendation regarding the application for conditional zoning #21CZ29. A motion was made by the Apex Planning Board to recommend approval; the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 3 for the application for #21CZ29;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §160D-601 and Sec. 2.2.11.E of the Unified Development Ordinance, the Director of Planning and Community Development caused proper notice to be given (by publication and posting), of a public hearing on #21CZ29 before the Apex Town Council on the 10th day of May 2022;

WHEREAS, the Apex Town Council held a public hearing on the 10th day of May 2022. Shelly Mayo, Planner II, presented the Planning Board's recommendation at the public hearing;

WHEREAS, all persons who desired to present information relevant to the application for #21CZ29 and who were residents of Apex or its extraterritorial jurisdiction, or who owned property adjoining the property for which the conditional zoning is sought, were allowed to present evidence at the public hearing before the Apex Town Council. No one who wanted to speak was turned away;

WHEREAS, the Apex Town Council finds that the approval of the rezoning is consistent with the 2045 Land Use Plan and other adopted plans in that: The 2045 Land Use Map designates the parcels north of North Salem St. as High Density Residential (Apartments Only)/Commercial Services and the parcels south of North Salem St as High Density Residential/Office Employment. This designation on the 2045 Land Use Map includes the zoning district Planned Unit Development-Conditional Zoning (PUD-CZ) and the Apex Town Council has further considered that the proposed rezoning to Planned Unit Development-Conditional Zoning (PUD-CZ) will maintain the character and appearance of the area and provide the flexibility to accommodate the growth in population, economy, and infrastructure consistent with that contemplated by the 2045 Land Use Map;

WHEREAS, the Apex Town Council finds that the approval of the rezoning is reasonable and in the public interest in that: The rezoning will support increased transit ridership, permit infill development, require greater environmental conditions than the existing zoning and provide an affordable housing option. The rezoning will encourage compatible development of the property and increase the tax base; and

WHEREAS, the Apex Town Council by a vote of 5 to 0 approved Application #21CZ29 rezoning the subject tract located at 0 Candun Drive, 0 Laura Duncan Road, and 0 N. Salem Street from Planned Commercial (PC) & Neighborhood Business (B1) to Planned Unit Development-Conditional Zoning (PUD-CZ).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APEX

Section 1: The lands that are the subject of the Ordinance are those certain lands described in Attachment “A” – Legal Description which is incorporated herein by reference, and said lands are hereafter referred to as the “Rezoned Lands.”

Ordinance Amending the Official Zoning District Map #21CZ29

Section 2: The Town of Apex Unified Development Ordinance, including the Town of Apex North Carolina Official Zoning District Map which is a part of said Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the zoning classification of the “Rezoned Lands” from Planned Commercial (PC) & Neighborhood Business (B1) to Planned Unit Development-Conditional Zoning (PUD-CZ) District, subject to the conditions stated herein.

Section 3: The Director of Planning and Community Development is hereby authorized and directed to cause the said Official Zoning District Map for the Town of Apex, North Carolina, to be physically revised and amended to reflect the zoning changes ordained by this Ordinance.

Section 4: The “Rezoned Lands” are subject to the conditions in Attachment “B” North Salem Station PUD which are imposed as part of this rezoning.

Section 5: The “Rezoned Lands” shall be perpetually bound to the conditions imposed including the uses authorized, unless subsequently changed or amended as provided for in the Unified Development Ordinance. Site plans for any development to be made pursuant to this amendment to the Official Zoning District Map shall be submitted for site plan approval as provided for in the Unified Development Ordinance.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
