## Italian American Heritage Month 2025

WHEREAS, Italian American Heritage Month has been celebrated each October since 1989, when it was federally recognized by the United States Congress and then-President George H.W. Bush; and,

WHEREAS, The United States has a strong connection with Italian Americans throughout its history, with over 16 million current US residents being from Italian descent, including several thousand here in Apex; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Apex is stronger, healthier, and more culturally diverse because of its Italian American residents and their contributions, and we are proud to celebrate their Heritage alongside them; and,

WHEREAS, The 7th Annual Festa Italiana will be held on September 20th from 11 AM - 7 PM along Hunter Street and on Town Hall Campus, which seeks to evoke the feelings of an Italian Street Festival through a celebration of Italian culture, music, food, wine, and more; and,

WHEREAS, We acknowledge that this year's Festa Italiana is celebrated in special honor and recognition of Mrs. Antoinette "Toni" Koytek, a resident of Apex who served on the Board of Directors for Festa Italiana, and passed away far too soon earlier this year.
