Item Details

During the June 24, 2025 Town Council meeting, the Mayor and the Town Council unanimously approved appointments to the Environmental Advisory Board (EAB). At that time, the Town Clerk's Office did not receive any applications for the voting youth position and was directed to recruit for a longer period of time.

- **Dhvani, Joshi** Corporate Limits Resident **Eligible for Voting Youth** Representative Position.
- Kadari, Samiksha Corporate Limits Resident Eligible for Voting Youth Representative Position.
- Strobl, Graham Corporate Limits Resident Eligible for Voting Youth Representative Position.
- Villasenor, Sandra Corporate Limits Resident Eligible for Voting Over 18 Representative Position
