Purpose of the Apex Transportation Plan

The Thoroughfare and Collector Street Plan Map, Transit Plan Map, and Bicycle and Pedestrian System Plan Map collectively represent a network of current and future facilities that provide guidance on what is likely to be suitable for long term growth, connectivity, recreation, and multimodal travel. The Transportation Plan does not provide a schedule for implementation, nor does it set aside funding for improvements. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider proposed amendments to the Thoroughfare and Collector Street Plan Map in order to make a decision.

A map of the proposed amendments to the Transportation Plan is displayed in Figure 1.

Explanation of Proposed Amendments

The amendments are associated with the proposed rezoning, 24CZ20 Hopson Gateway Planned Unit Development (PUD).

The primary amendment is to realign the future major collector street between Tingen Road and Perry Road. The revised alignment is proposed to: (1) avoid changes to the full-movement access at the existing driveways along Perry Road, (2) plan for needed spacing of intersections along Perry Road that would also accommodate future development, (3) plan for needed spacing of intersections along Tingen Road, and (4) minimize stream impacts in comparison to the adopted plan alignment. Related amendments include shifting the roundabout planned along Tingen Road and extending the future local connector.
