Motion to approve ADA Paratransit Agreement Amendment and Renewal No. 3 between Wake County and Town of Apex, to renew the agreement and to update the maximum operating cost to \$132.60 per hour, and to authorize the Town Manager, or their designee, to execute on behalf of the Town.

Item Details

The ADA Paratransit Service Agreement between Town of Apex and Wake County establishes the terms and responsibilities for the operation of the GoApex Route 1 complementary paratransit service, known as GoApex Door to Door. The main purpose of this proposed amendment is to renew the agreement and to update the maximum operating cost to \$132.60 per hour. Note, a similar amendment was approved by Town Council on August 12, 2025; however, it was not executed as Wake County determined it could not provide the service at the previously agreed-upon maximum operating cost of \$105.96 per hour.

This amendment also updates Attachment A, the GoApex ADA Paratransit Policy to remove the following language under the section on Schedule: *"At a to-be-determined date, GoApex Route 1 may begin operating on Sundays from 7:00am to 9:00pm and on all holidays except Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, and may operate a modified schedule on Christmas Eve."* This change is needed as Wake County has confirmed that they will not be able to expand paratransit service to include Sundays due to limitations of their contract with their contracted service provider. Town staff will be investigating other options.
