

DRAFT SUMMARY MINUTES

**TOWN OF APEX
COMMUNITY TOWN HALL
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2025
6:00 PM**

A **Community Town Hall**, which included members of the **Apex Town Council**, was held on **Thursday, October 23, 2025** at the **Electric Utilities Operations Center** located at 2850 Milano Avenue in Apex, North Carolina. The event began at **6:00 p.m.**

[COMMENCEMENT]

Councilmember Mahaffey opened the event at **6:02 p.m.** and welcomed all in attendance. He said this event was intended to be very informal and encouraged members to speak respectfully.
