## Cyber Security Awareness Month 2023

WHEREAS, Cyber Security Awareness Month is an internationally recognized campaign held each October to promote cyber security and offer education about its importance; and,

WHEREAS, Risks to privacy online represent a serious threat to an individual's finances, medical history, identity information, and sensitive documents; and,
