Having lived in Apex for more than a decade now, I've watched our town change throughout the years. Even as our town grows, I want to preserve what makes this area truly special to me - the natural environment. I have watched huge sections of trees get cut down for new neighborhoods and seen grassy meadows that were havens for pollinators get covered by large townhouses. But I've also witnessed the way people can come together to save an incredibly old tree that's seen Apex grow since the very beginning. It's these kinds of experiences that inspire me to join the government board as a youth representative. I want to be able to help make big projects more sustainable and safer for the native flora and fauna. Also, since I'm very involved in my school community, I would love to be able to help connect students to Apex and the environment, because I've seen what can happen when we all come together to support our environment. I'm eager to use my creativity and problem-solving skills to improve the natural environment. It would be such an honor to make a positive impact on the trees, parks, and green spaces that always make Apex feel like home to me.

**Please describe three (3) reasons why your service on the chosen board could be beneficial to the Town of Apex.**

One reason why my service would be beneficial is that my age can not only provide the board with a different perspective on the issues that it is presented with, but can also connect it with a whole new demographic that is typically a little more difficult to reach. I'm involved in several clubs at my school, and have leadership positions in many of them, which will make it easy for me to reach out and educate groups of kids on the importance of the environment and the ways that they can get involved. Secondly, my service will be beneficial to the environmental advisory board because I have lived in Apex for almost my whole life. This means I know exactly how Apex has changed over the years, giving me a unique perspective on what green spaces and environments have been lost. It also allows me to have a more long-term vision for Apex. I'm ready to make decisions based on my knowledge of both how the town has grown over the years and the path it needs to take in the future. Finally, my service will be beneficial because I already know how to look at and explain complex problems, especially through a scientific lens. I've won multiple awards at Speech and Debate and state level awards at competitions like DECA (large business competition). I am also a leader in the Women in Science and Engineering club. All of these experiences come together to give me the skills to analyze complex issues regarding the environment and make the right decision.

**If appointed to your preferred board, please describe your top three (3) goals or initiatives you would hope to achieve during your term.**

One of my top initiatives for this term is to increase awareness about Apex's environment among our youth, and to spread the word about ways that the younger generation can get involved. Specifically, I'd like to connect either a club that I create or existing clubs at my school, such as Key Club (a club dedicated to volunteering), to the Environmental Advisory Board by sharing ways for kids to volunteer and contribute to keeping Apex clean and beautiful. I believe that the more the younger generation is educated about the environment and the more they are able to participate in keeping the environment clean and healthy, the more likely they are to become good stewards of the environment later on. Another one of my top initiatives is to make sure that Apex's rapid development is balanced out with the improvement of existing green spaces, such as planting more native plants and increasing support of little-known environmental problems. For example, one important but overlooked issue is the knowledge and support of building sustainable habitats for native pollinators. While the new building projects in Apex are essential, I think we should also be making sure that Apex remains as healthy and green as ever, since that is part of the main charm of our town! The final goal I want to achieve during my term is to advocate for strict environmental criteria when it comes to new projects, such as the data centers potentially coming to Apex. As I have read in Mr. Terry Mahaffey's updates, the decision on data centers has been pushed off, and one of the key reasons is environmental issues such as water usage and pollution. I hope to push for strict guidelines so that if data centers do end up in Apex, they will not poison the environment, allowing our town to retain its green spaces.

**Please describe your recent volunteer experience and how this positively contributed to the Town of Apex.**

Although I applied for the Apex Youth Council, due to the overwhelming number of applicants in the lottery-based system, I unfortunately wasn't chosen to become a member. This led me to find new, more creative ways to get involved in the community. I do a lot of volunteering in my school, such as mentoring younger members in my Speech and Debate club. This has taught me skills such as communication and ways to make difficult topics easy to understand. These will be invaluable in connecting Apex's youth to issues in the environment. I also serve on my school's WISE council board, and was just reelected to my second year. In this role, I help plan and lead meetings, educating about 100 young women in my school about different aspects of science. My connection to WISE and my experience as a student leader will be very helpful on the environmental advisory board.






