**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Appomattox wishes to recognize Deputy Duvall's service and to express the Town's gratitude for the positive difference he made in the lives of others;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Council of the Town of Appomattox hereby honors the life and memory of **Deputy Burlie Winfoot Duvall III** and extends its sincere gratitude for his service to the citizens of Appomattox County and the greater Appomattox community; and
