

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2025-07**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF APPLE VALLEY, UTAH, AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT OF A FIRE SUPPRESSION VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley (the "Town") is committed to protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, an urgent need has arisen to obtain a fire suppression vehicle due to emergency conditions posing an immediate threat to public safety, including the risk of wildfire and inadequate emergency response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-6a-803 and the Town's procurement policy, emergency procurement procedures are permitted when the delay involved in standard purchasing processes would threaten the public health, welfare, or safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town has identified the immediate need to procure a fire suppression vehicle and has located a suitable vendor, Garage Technologies, Inc, offering a vehicle that meets the Town's emergency response requirements at a cost of \$150,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is convened in a properly noticed special meeting on April 23, 2025, to consider and approve the emergency purchase as a matter of public necessity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Apple Valley, Utah as follows:

- 1. Emergency Declaration: The Town Council hereby declares that an emergency exists requiring the immediate procurement of a fire suppression vehicle, in order to preserve and protect the public health and safety.
- 2. Authorization to Purchase: The Town Council hereby authorizes and approves the emergency purchase of one fire suppression vehicle from Garage Technologies, Inc in the amount of \$150,000.00.
- 3. Procurement Compliance: The Town Council affirms that the purchase is being made under the emergency procurement provisions of applicable state and local law and directs staff to complete all required documentation to comply with these provisions.
- Budget Authorization: The Town Council authorizes the necessary budget allocation or amendment to fund the purchase from available resources or designated emergency response funds.
- 5. Administrative Direction: The Mayor, or their designee, is directed to carry out all steps necessary to complete the procurement, including contract execution, fund disbursement, and coordination of delivery.

EFFECTIVE DATE  This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Town Council.
